Dr. Zuna-Kratky has been heading the Technical Museum in Vienna since 1 January 2000. This federal scientific institution of public law constitutes an outsourced legal entity stipulated in the Act on Federal Museums, which is registered with the Companies' Register. This Act shapes the rights and obligations of these legal entities in various aspects in a similar way to those of corporations under private law. The Technical Museum is for instance obliged to present its audited annual report, consisting of a strategy report and a forecast, including a business plan, a profit and loss account, a budgeted balance sheet and a budget and financing forecast, and is as well in other matters required to be organised and to act in an "entrepreneurial" way. As long-term Managing Director of the Technical Museum, Dr. Zuna-Kratky disposes of sufficient experience and knowledge to perform her tasks in the supervisory board of Erste Bank.
