

New Procurement and Travel Management Directors

As part of its groups project, Erste Bank der oesterreichischen Sparkassen AG will be consolidating all procurement activities of the Erste Bank Group together with its facility management activities (man-agement and operation of buildings and properties) into a single company, Procurement Services GmbH or s Proserv in short. These activities will be managed by Nima Motazed.

Nima Motazed (born in 1967 in Innsbruck) joined Erste Bank in 2001 after working for Bank Austria for ten years. His first post was as programme manager for the easd+ project for the conversion of the computer systems of Erste Bank und Sparkassen in 2001 and 2002, after which he was responsible for the evaluation of the IT projects of the Erste Bank Group. After Postabank was integrated into Erste Bank Hungary, a project which he also managed, Nima Motazed was appointed chief procurement offi-cer in the procurement, property and facility management project in 2004, and is now managing the newly founded **s Proserv**.

Erste Bank's **travel management** was also integrated into s Proserv (Procurement Services GmbH) and has been under new management since the beginning of July. Doris Braunias (born in Vienna in 1963) has worked at a number of travel agencies since 1980. After completing her training at Renner travel agency and then working for Farnik Reisen and Nova Reisen for a number of years, she was appointed manager of the business travel centre at Raiffeisen Reisen. There, her responsibilities in-cluded company and airline contracts including sales management, budgeting and personnel manage-ment. **Doris Braunias** was most recently account manager for corporate customers at AirPlus Air Travel Card Vertriebsgesellschaft m.b.H. before she took over travel management at Erste Bank on 1 July.
