EUR 50 million acquisition financing of Polbita Sp. z o.o. and its flagship brand "Drogerie Natura", the leading personal care retail chain in Poland, by Interchem, the leading Polish distributor of household products and personal care goods.

Utilities, healthcare, natural resources as well as consumer goods will remain in focus in Poland. Since customers require more specialized products than the ones they can find in supermarkets, the share of specialized cosmetic shops on the Polish market already exceeds 50%. According to a recent study, 53% of women and 35% of men in Poland purchase their cosmetic products at personal care retailers. This explains why the number of personal care retail chains significantly increased in 2010, whereas the number of small traditional shops declined. In 2010, Polish people spent about EUR 1 billion on cosmetic products, 1.3% less than in 2009.
