

Make your own Christmas decorations with us

What do you need?


Thin paper, which can even be sufficiently large remnants of wrapping paper. Scissors, a pencil, glue, clothespins and ribbon or string.

Template

You can print out any of the included patterns, or you can come up with and draw your own shape.


1) Let's do it

- **A)** Fold the paper with the nicer side on the inside.
- B) Apply the template and trace it with a pencil.
- **C)** Cut it out. You need **20 of the same parts** for one decoration.




2) First gluing

- **D)** Glue each piece on the inside in the middle according to the drawings on pages 4-6. The glue must not get on the outer edge, so preferably use it sparingly.
- **E)** Fasten the glued parts together with the clothespins until the glue dries.



3) Second gluing


- **F)** Apply the glue on the outside according to the second drawing.
- **G)** Successively glue all of the parts together and fasten them in place.



H) Leave the last part without glue for now. Coat the ridge with glue and let it dry properly. You can colour the outer edge with a metallic marker.


4) And we're almost done

I) Glue the string or ribbon to the ridge.




- J) On the upper side, repeat "second gluing".
- **K)** Unfold the shape, nicely join the sides together and fasten them in place.


Once the glue has dried, put the decoration on your Christmas tree.




