

What is Erste mToken?

Erste **mToken** is a means for login to e-banking and mobile banking services, and it is an integral part of the Erste mBanking application.


This means you can log in to NetBanking and mBanking not only via the **TAN card**, but using mToken, as well. This ensures a simpler, safer and contemporary access to e-business.


mToken can be activated on maximum 3 devices.

The new mToken can be activated on the same device once the existing mToken is blocked.

mToken can be activated only via the TAN card by clicking on the **"mToken"** icon or **"Login to mBanking"** icon on the home screen in the mBanking application. The first step is to accept the General Terms and Conditions for activating mToken.

mToken Activation

After accepting the General Terms and Conditions, please enter your username (in capital letters) and password.

The next step is to enter the appropriate field from the TAN card (row and column). Before activating mToken, please select mPIN (**4-digit number** related to mToken) which is intended for login to mBanking and NetBanking.

In the final step of the activation, the application offers the option to set up mToken as a **predefined** login method.







Setup via the "Settings" icon








In order to log each time to mBanking by entering your defined 4-digit mPIN, please set mToken as a predefined method of login to mBanking. This can be done:

- via the "Login to mBanking" icon on the login method selection screen or the mPIN input screen,
- via the "Settings" icon,
- on the screen that is displayed last **during mToken activation** (shown on page 4).







Once Erste mToken is activated, you can use the "mToken" icon to:


- Create a one-time password for logging to NetBanking

- Sign a payment order on NetBanking






To log in to NetBanking, you should first enter the mPIN you defined when mToken was activated.


When you click on a "One-time password" icon, the information required to log in to NetBanking will be displayed:


- mToken serial number
- One-time password


Signing a payment order on NetBanking with mToken

To sign a payment order on NetBanking, you should first enter the mPIN you defined when the mToken was activated.

When you click on "Signing", the screen displaying the information to be signed will be opened. Please enter the number from NetBanking enquiry in the "Challenge" field. When you click on "Generate response", the number which should be entered in NetBanking to sign the payment order will appear in "Response" field.

Change mPIN

To change the mPIN, you should first enter the mPIN you defined when mToken was first activated.


Select the "Change mPIN" option.


Enter the current mPIN you want to change.


Enter the new mPIN you want to use in the future.


Confirm the new mPIN you want to use in the future.











Blocking mToken

You can block mToken by clicking the icons:


- Login to mBanking

The mPIN input window will open. Please click on the three dots in the upper right corner of the screen.




Once a new window is opened, select "Block mToken".
